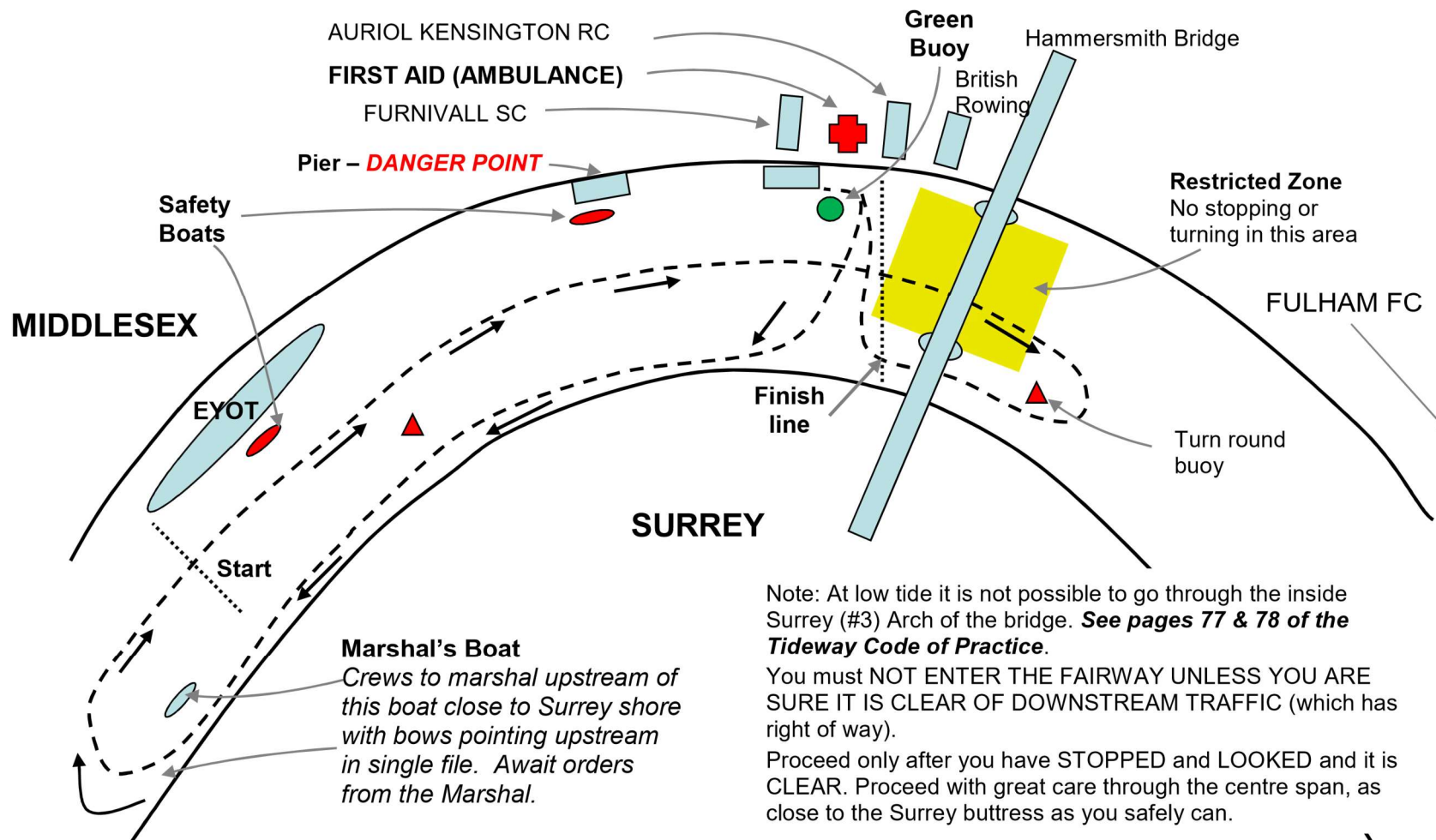


CIRCULATION PATTERN

FALLING TIDE (low water 19:25)

Racing downstream (ebb) from 12:05 until 18:30

Note: after boating, we recommend that crews allow themselves to drift downstream of the green buoy before crossing



Note: At low tide it is not possible to go through the inside Surrey (#3) Arch of the bridge. **See pages 77 & 78 of the Tideway Code of Practice.**

You must NOT ENTER THE FAIRWAY UNLESS YOU ARE SURE IT IS CLEAR OF DOWNSTREAM TRAFFIC (which has right of way).

Proceed only after you have STOPPED and LOOKED and it is CLEAR. Proceed with great care through the centre span, as close to the Surrey buttress as you safely can.

Note: Any practice should be conducted well upstream of the start. Crews should continue upstream on Surrey close to bank, and turn into the middle of the river to come down with the tide. Care should be exercised for other river users travelling in the fairway. **Be aware that the Chiswick crossing point is just above the pier.**
